LCIF GRANT RECIPIENTS

LCIF Grant funds were given to ten Clubs in District 2-E2. All have agreed to follow all guidelines and requirements from LCIF. The Lions are

MORE LCIF GRANT FUNDS went to the Azle Lions Club. Members met with Azle Independent School District and Nine Mile Ministries to locate families in their community affected by the recent 2021 Snow Storm. Each of the three families affected all had freezing pipes. Lions purchased \$600 worth of food and water. Each family received \$200 worth of groceries. Azle Lions were able to plan a "Free Water Giveaway" due to their efforts to get cases of water donated to the community.

MARCH IS VISION SAFETY MONTH

The LOEB ceased lending equipment during the height of the pandemic in the interest of protecting children and Lions. We have recently started considering individual requests to borrow equipment that include a plan to protect the children and Lions for situations that are urgent. There are specific manufacturer guidelines we need to follow to disinfect any equipment we loan so that we do not damage the equipment but it is safe for the next person.

While the LOEB is not loaning equipment directly, there are some clubs that have been able to conduct vision screenings. Recently, the Burleson Club was able to perform 402 vision screenings for pre-k and kindergarten in the Burleson Independent School District before the terrible weather hit, and they had 79 referrals.

We have received several Vision Assistance Grant applications this Lion year, but we have more money budgeted for 2020-2021! If you know a non-Lion in need of a grant to fund eye-saving surgery, please consider assisting them in applying for a Vision Assistance Grant through the LOEB.

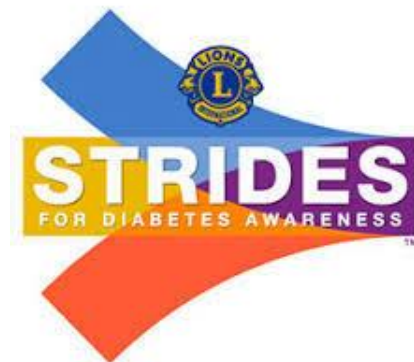
PEACE POSTER WINNER

LET'S PLAY GOLF this Summer and support TEXAS LIONS CAMP!

Texas Lions Camp invites you to participate in 2021 and join us for the **28th Annual Harry Wickersham Golf Tournament, which is scheduled for Thursday, August 5, 2021** at the Lady Bird Johnson Golf Course in Fredericksburg.

The Harry Wickersham Golf Tournament is one of the primary fundraisers which supports annual operations for Texas Lions Camp. Each year, hundreds of children with special medical conditions attend TLC thanks to the financial gifts from the Lions of Texas and community friends.

For Golfers, the 2021 Golf Tournament is open to men and women and the event will consist of four-person teams (limited to 31 teams) and formatted as a Florida Scramble/Best Ball with a shotgun start at 8 AM. The Entry Fee is \$110 per golfer and a team of four golfers is \$440 (before July 1, 2021) or \$125 per person or a team of four golfers is \$500 (after July 1, 2021). Following the round of golf, a CATERED MEAL will be provided by our host club, Fredericksburg Lions Club, followed by an AWARDS PROGRAM both of which will be appropriately socially distanced.

If you do not play golf, then consider becoming a **HOLE SPONSOR** by sending in a check for \$100 or more. Your Club name/individual name will be listed and recognized at Lady Bird Johnson Golf Course on the Day of the Tournament on a District Hole Sponsor poster.
