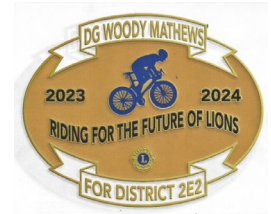

INFORMATION FOR CONTESTANTS

A. Contest Purpose

Identify, recognize, and reward the High School (HS) Junior or Senior student, or immediate graduate, who, above others, has excelled in academics, leadership, and community service.

B. Who is Eligible to Enter?

- (1) Full time student in a Texas High School or comparable education program and,
- (2) High School Junior or Senior, or immediate graduate at the time of the District contest

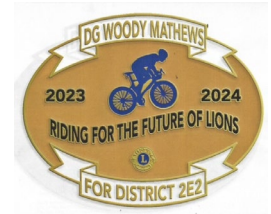
C. Become A Contestant

- (1) Complete a **Contest Application** form. This form is included with this Contestant Package and is also available on the District 2-E2 Outstanding Youth Contest website - [Outstanding Youth Contest | LIONS DISTRICT 2E2 \(lions2e2.org\)](https://lions2e2.org). **This form must be type written** – no handwritten applications will be accepted)
- (2) Prepare a contest entry package containing the following:
 - a. Four (4) copies of the typed State Contest Application, each signed by the contestant and a parent/guardian.
 - b. One (1) certified high school transcript, plus three (3) copies.
 - c. Four (4) typed copies of a biographical information statement highlighting community service and leadership experience/participation experience.
 - d. Three (3) letters of recommendation and three (3) copies of all three recommendation letters.
 - e. Four (4) high-quality wallet/passport photographs (such as a current school picture) that are of the head-and-shoulders, glossy and in color.
 - f. Four (4) typed double spaced copies of your 750 to 1000 word essay with word count on last page of essay.

Essay: ***“Impact of Climate Change: A Complex Issue”*** (750-1000 words)
Climate change impacts are seen throughout every aspect of the world we live in. It’s interrelated to different sectors of society. Things that we depend upon and value such as water, energy, transportation, wildlife, agriculture, ecosystems, and human health are experiencing the effects of a changing climate. Drought can harm food production and human health. Flooding can lead to the spread of diseases. Human health issues can increase mortality. Climate change impacts differ between neighborhoods or individuals. So, what can we do about it and how should we cope with climate change?

INFORMATION FOR CONTESTANTS

In this essay, the contestant should reflect on different environmental issues, what's causing these issues, and what solution(s) are the experts recommending limiting the negative outcomes of climate change. The essay must be well organized, have good vocabulary and conform to required length.

- (3) Submit **Four (4) copies** of the contest entry package directly to the local sponsoring Lions Club by **December 1, 2023**.

D. Become a Lions Club-Sponsored Contestant to the District 2-E2 Contest

Submit contest entry package to a participating local Lions Club. That Club will select/sponsor one contestant to participate in the District 2-E2 contest. If you need assistance in obtaining a club to sponsor an applicant, please contact the District 2-E2 Outstanding Youth Chair noted at the bottom of this document.

E. District 2-E2 Contest (Interview) Saturday, January 20, 2024 – Irma Marsh Middle School, 415 Hagg Drive, River Oaks, TX 76114.

- (1) Check in with the Outstanding Youth Coordinator **No Later than 9:00 am**. At least one parent/guardian should accompany the contestant.
- (2) Each contestant will participate in an informal interview of about 15 minutes before 3 judges.
- (3) Attire should be suitable for church or a job interview.
- (4) The order of interviews will be by a draw.
- (5) Contestants remain in a separate waiting area until invited to enter the interview room.
- (6) Contestants simply state their name only to begin the interview.
- (7) Contestants will return to the waiting room after their interview.
- (8) All contestants will be presented at the day's luncheon, at which time winners will be announced. Lunch for contestants and parents/guardians are free of charge.
- (9) Two (2) scholarships will be awarded:
Winner: \$2,000 (sponsored by District 2-E2)
Runner Up: \$1,000 (sponsored by 2-E2 Eyeglass Recycling Center)

F. Judging Criteria

- (1) ***"Impact of Climate Change: A Complex Issue"*** Essay (15%).
- (2) Grade Point Average (5%).
- (3) Letters of Recommendation (15%).
- (4) Biographical information statement, community service, leadership experience/ participation information (35%).
- (5) Personal Interview (30%).

G. To Collect Scholarship Winnings

- (1) Have the registrar of the college, junior college, or vocational school send verification of registration and associated account number (including the student's full name) to the Lions District 2-E2 Treasurer, Don Noblit, at the following address: P.O. Box 820895, North Richland Hills, TX 76182.
- (2) Upon receipt of the above, a check will be mailed to the school.
- (3) Request for payment must be received no later than 2 years following the recipient's graduation from high school.

H. State Outstanding Youth Contest

- (1) The Lions District 2-E2 first place winner advances to represent the District at the State competition, which will be held **online on Saturday, May 4, 2024**. The first place winner must also attend an online orientation to be held **Saturday, April 27, 2024**.
- (2) The Lions District 2-E2 runner-up will represent the District at the State contest if the first-place winner is unable to do so and is approved by the Lions MD-2 (Multi-District 2) Contest Chairman.
- (3) The contestant must comply with all contest rules found at <https://texaslions.org/outstanding-youth-award/>.

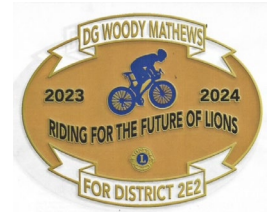

BACKGROUND: The Lions District 2-E2 Outstanding Youth Contest for 2023-2024 will be held on Saturday, January 20, 2024. This contest is an annual competition allowing high school juniors and seniors to apply for the Texas Lions Outstanding Youth Scholarship Award (OYA), with district winners progressing to the State competition. Contestants are evaluated on their 750 to 1,000 word essay, high school grade point average, personal biographical information statement, performance of community service, leadership experience/participation, three letters of recommendation, and a personal interview.

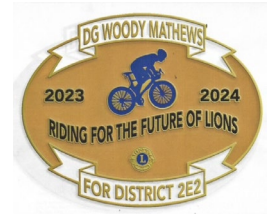
WINNERS: **1st PLACE** – \$2,000 Scholarship*

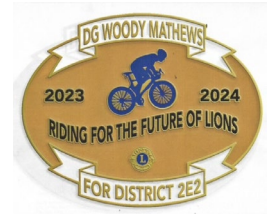

- Complete contestant application FORM (typed, not handwritten) that can be found on the District 2-E2 Outstanding Youth Contest website - [Outstanding Youth Contest | LIONS DISTRICT 2E2 \(lions2e2.org\)](https://lions2e2.org). 4 typed and signed copies.
- Complete 750-1,000 word essay on "Impact of Climate Change: A Complex Issue" - typed - double-spaced. Word count shown on last page. Four (4) copies.
- One (1) certified high school transcript, plus three (3) copies.
- Four (4) typed copies of biographical information statement highlighting community service and leadership experience/participation experience.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation and three (3) copies of all recommendation letters.
- Four (4) high-quality wallet/passport photographs (such as a current school picture) that are of the head-and-shoulders, glossy and in color.
- Personal interview on January 20, 2024.
- Meet deadlines and complete application package requirements.

CRITERIA:

- 750 - 1,000 word essay on **“Impact of Climate Change: A Complex Issue”**. In this essay, the contestant should reflect on different environmental issues, what’s causing these issues, and what solution(s) are the experts recommending limiting the negative outcomes of climate change. The essay must be well organized, have good vocabulary and conform to required length. **Fifteen percent (15%)**.
- Grade point average from certified high school official transcript. **Five percent (5%)**.
- Three (3) letters of recommendation. **Fifteen percent (15%)**.
- Biographical information statement, community service, leadership experience/participation experience. **Thirty-Five percent (35%)**.
- Personal Interview-the personal interview may include matters on current local, state, national or worldwide events. Will be conducted in the English language. **Thirty percent (30%)**.

ADVANCING TO STATE COMPETITION:

- The District 2-E2 Winner will advance to the State competition which will be held online on **Saturday, May 4, 2024**, with an orientation on **Saturday, April 27, 2024**. Contestants must be able to participate in the Orientation and the Contest using online live audio and video communication tools. Zoom video conferencing app will be used for the contest.
- The District 2-E2 Runner Up may advance to State Competition, if the Winner cannot attend and is approved by the MD-2 (State) Contest Chairman.
- Scholarships of \$3,000 (1st Place), \$2,000 (2nd Place) and \$1,000 (3rd Place) will be awarded for winners at the State contest.
- Winner (or Runner Up, if Winner cannot compete at State level and the Runner Up is approved) must satisfy all State-level entry requirements found at <https://texaslions.org/outstanding-youth-award/>.
