Bridgeport Lions Aid Local Boy

Late in August, Jake Martinez, President of the Bridgeport Lions Club, received a request for medical assistance funding for a 5 year old boy. The lad had a severe medical issue – a cleft palate which led to a condition called Eustachion Tube Dysfunction. This condition, if left Untreated, can lead to velopharyngeal insufficiency (VPI) in which foods constantly reflux up in to the back of the nose. This then leads to chronic adenoid inflammation or enlargement, and can contribute to nasal and sinus inflammation. Other results of this condition include issues with speaking and hearing (up to loss of hearing) as well as difficulty when breathing and consuming food and drink. If this is left untreated during early life, ocular complications may arise and become progressive – to the point where sight could be damaged. This young man already, at 5 years of age, had all of these issues.

The mother of the child was the main financial provider of the household. Due to issues related to the global COVID-19 pandemic, she was laid off from her job in May. Since then, she actively searched for a new job and has only now been granted a new job position. The mother had been able to obtain most of the \$8406 she needed to have (after insurance payments) for the surgery, however, the job setback caused a financial burden upon the family and to give up the final \$1,500 to perform the surgery on time would threaten the

livelihood of the entire household, to include inability to pay rent or to purchase food for the family.

This family reached out to the Lions Club as a last resort. Lion Martinez was familiar with the family and knew that they would not request any funding without a dire need. While initial complications related to the young boy's medical issue do not immediately affect vision or eyes, it has the potential to cause negative effects in that regard in the future if it is not treated at a young age. A little boy is hurting. He cannot speak properly, he cannot eat, he cannot hear. We had the ability and the means to help and the donation of the funds would not significantly burden the club financially. Simply put, a child needed our help.

After consultation with the manager of our Eyeglass Foundation, the Club decided to provide the funds to the family. The Bridgeport Lions Club is happy to report that the surgery was performed on September 1, 2020 and the boy is already eating and drinking without the food/drink moving up into his nose. The surgery also repaired the cleft palate, so the young boy now has a much better chance for a long and healthy life. The Bridgeport Lions Club is proud to exemplify our motto – WE SERVE!

LIONS CLUB INTERNATIONAL REMINDER!

Please remember that all Lions clubs, districts and multiple districts with annual gross receipts less than US \$50,000 who are not otherwise required to file Forms 990 or 990-EZ must file the e-Postcard (also known as 990-N). If your Lions club, district or multiple district has a foundation, which is a separate legal entity, the appropriate form will need to be filed as well.

November 15 each year. Please note that an organization cannot request an

extension for filing the Form 990-N.
