This exceptional opportunity can be provided to all schools - Grades K-8 in your School District at no Cost. **The curriculum and training are FREE** for all schools participating in the one-year pilot.

### **Lions Quest International will provide:**

In person three-hour teacher, staff and administration training. The in-person training normally costs \$2700 for each school training. The curriculum, visuals, and additional teacher resources are available on each trained educator's computer.

There are 17 lessons lasting only 30 minutes. There are an additional 24 more lessons which are thirty minutes in length. Additional lessons and resources are available on each trained educator's computer.

Every teacher or staff member has access to all grade levels of the curriculum and family connection resources at no cost.
