Lions and Leos Serve in Many Ways



Service activities: Hands-on service activities, such as tree planting, vision screening, rebuilding homes after disaster strikes or serving meals to those in need.

Advocacy: Raising awareness of the causes that are important to Lions, educating our communities on issues that impact them and working with others to bring about positive change. Some examples include hosting a Strides walk for diabetes awareness or visiting a local lawmaker to discuss the needs of the blind or visually impaired.

Donations: Making charitable donations to individuals or organizations, including Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF). Funds donated to LCIF are tracked by the foundation and need not be reported as a service activity.


Fundraising: Raising funds to enable our service.

SERVICE SUPPORT ACTIVITIES

FOUR broad categories:

- 1 Holding meetings to strengthen your club, educate and train members, or plan other service activities.
- 2 Fulfilling administrative tasks, such as running errands, maintaining club records, or reporting.
- 3 Attending Lions events such as conventions and forums.
- 4 Engaging in fellowship and fun, together with other Lions.

These activities contribute to Lions' positive impact in various ways, including attracting new members to clubs, helping clubs retain members by providing a positive experience, preparing Lions to serve, or directly benefitting the people we serve.





What is not reportable service?

Many Lions and Leos serve their communities individually, outside of the activities planned by their clubs, districts or multiple districts. Some examples include bringing a meal to a neighbor, driving a parent to a medical appointment, or volunteering at their place of worship. This type of work is important and commendable; however, it should not be reported as a Lions' service activity.

LOGGING IN

<u>First</u> – using your Search Engine (Google, DuckDuckGo, Bing, etc.) <u>Search for mylci login – Set up an account or login if you have one.</u>






After Log-in you will be directed to this page. If you are taking care of club membership business click on MyLCI.

<u>Click on MyLion</u> if you are entering Service Hours or Activities. <u>You will not have a Newsfeed until you set it up on this page!</u> Once you enter MyLion your page will look something like this. <u>CLICK on Plan Future Activity</u> to set up your club's


Signature Activities

Instructions are clear once you enter the next window!




If you have a logo for a Signature Activity there is space to enter it! If not use your club logo or what LCI offers. You can always edit once posted.







Select Your Activity Type


After each selection hit Continue to move through your selection process.

Once your reach the window to fill out your activity there are a few things to pay attention to:


- Club or District?

These activities will show up once you log into MyLion in the future.




You will enter Service Hours from this page CLICK on **Report Past Activity**

This is the next page you will see. Enter your Activity Name (if this is to report on a Signature Activity be sure to name that correctly).

Check the following:


- Club or District Activity Level

The rest is selfexplanatory. Just double check before you Submit your report. To check on posted activities CLICK on <u>Activities</u> in the MyLion window.

You will see <u>Filters</u> that allow you to choose a variety of ways to view your club or district activities.

Explore to discover which of these filters offers the information you need to keep your club up to date!

Club Secretaries can post Club Service Hours, but individual Members can also post their own hours by going through the same process shown in this presentation!






WHY POST SERVICE HOURS?
